2nd ANNUAL GREAT MARLIN RACE AUGUST 2 - 6, 2010

Teams or individual anglers participating in the 51st HIBT will have an opportunity to sponsor a satellite tag in the 2010 Great Marlin Race

The race will be monitored by Dr. Barbara Block and her Stanford University research team

All proceeds will be used for Pacific Blue Marlin research

The race will run for 120 days. The Pacific Blue Marlin traveling the furthest in that time period will be declared the winner

The winner will receive a free entry for up to 6 anglers in the 52nd HIBT (does not include charter boat fees, lodging, or travel costs).

Satellite tag purchases are tax deductible as a charitable contribution in the United States. Deductibility may vary in other countries
